WALNUT - The Ayala boys varsity team had a strong showing at the Mt. SAC Cross Country Invitational, finishing fourth in the Division 1 & 2 High School Boys Three Mile Individual Sweepstakes.

The Bulldogs finished with 150 points and a team time of 1:21:38.

"You have to be able to run well at Mt. SAC to do well at the end of the season," head Coach Steve Pye said. "It was really about getting out on the course. We had some guys it was their first time running the course."

Senior Tyler Reed led the way with a 17th place finish and a time of 15:42.

"He's ranked third in the state in Division II," Pye said of his senior runner. "First day for him running here again, he's looking to be league champ."

Junior Justin Wright finished 29th with a time of 16:13; junior Alex Keifer finished 34th with a time of 16:24; senior Robert Tanner finished 42nd with a time of 16:33; junior Cole Firman finished 54th with a time of 16:46; junior Taylor Nasu finished 55th with a time of 16:47 and junior Trevor Corsello finished 73rd with a time of 17:11.

The lady Bulldogs weren't as successful, finishing 16th in the Division 1&2 High School Girls Three Mile Individual Sweepstakes but head coach Dawn Staab was pleased with the performance.

"It's a new team and they're building as they go," Staab said. "We're pushing for the end of the season and to open up with the times that they did today, I'm really happy they did it."
